

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Superintendent or designee shall prepare for Board approval a plan consisting of district graduation requirements. Students shall receive diplomas of graduation from high school after meeting the district graduation requirements, as well as successful completion of any required high school competency examination:

Language Arts	4 credits
Math	3 credits
Social Studies	3.5 credits
Science	3 credits
Physical Education	1 credit
Health	.5 credit
Fine Arts	1 credit
Vocational Education	2 credits
Senior Project	.5 credit
Electives	to meet the total number of required credits
